## Ephesians 4:17-24 "The New Man"

- I. How are Christians *NOT* supposed to act (live) 4:1?
  - A. Not like the rest of the world (Or. Gr. for "the rest of the Gentiles" = rest of the nations) -2 Cor. 6:17; 1 Pet. 4:1-3. How does the rest of the world walk?
    - 1.) V.17 in the futility of their mind. Christians are to think differently.
      - a.) Futility Or. Gr. =  $\underline{\text{vanity}}$  = hollow; worthless; useless. An emptiness as to results = a pointless endeavor. Like a screen door on a submarine!
        - i.) There are a lot of futile mentalities in the world today; both outside and inside the church - Col. 2:8.
        - 11.) The most useless, worthless, hollow endeavors anyone can take up is something they deem worthy that God sees as frivolous.
        - iii.) The only thing worse than being unsuccessful in the things important to man, is being successful in the things God sees as unimportant.
        - iv.) "Our inventions are wont to be pretty toys, which distract our attention from serious things. We have improved means to unimproved ends." - Henry David Thoreau
        - V.) "Our world today has a great deal of knowledge but very little wisdom." - Warren Wiersbe
    - 2.) V.18 with a <u>darkened</u> (deprived of light) understanding Rom. 1:20-22, 28. The Light they are deprived of & need most is what they have rejected: Jesus – John 3:17-21.
    - 3.) V.18 <u>alienated</u> (separated; estranged) from God.
      - a.) What separates us from God? Sin! Is. 59:2 the lifestyles, worldviews, opinions, mentalities of the world.
      - b.) The farther away we get from God the more clouded our minds become! - Is. 26:3; James 4:8 - double minded = vacillating = wavering; indecisive.
    - 4.) V.18 internal ignorance 1 Pet. 1:13-16.
    - 5.) V.18 <u>blindness</u> (stupidity; hardness; callousness) of heart.
      - a.) All of these things work backwards:
        - i.) Their heart is hardened <u>because</u> of their ignorance because of their distance from God because their understanding has been darkened by the futility of their mind.
      - b.) And what is the cause of all this?
    - 6.) V.19 past feeling = apathy; callousness; numbness
      - a.) A natural result of futile thinking, darkened understanding, separation from God, internal ignorance and a blind heart: we become numb to the things of God altogether.
      - b.) Part of this is the natural consequences of sin & another part is God giving people what they constantly pursue – Rom. 1:28; 1 Tim. 4:1-2.
    - 7.) V.19 self-surrendering to sin: "given themselves over to <u>lewdness</u>" - Gr. = unrestrained immorality; lacking remorse.
    - 8.) V.19 self-centered "to work all uncleanness with greediness"
      - a.) The main objective behind sinful living/choices is selfgratification, in spite of who it may hurt or the consequences/impact on others – 2 Cor. 5:14-15.
